

## Exports of travel services

**Description:** Total value of exports in travel services (millions). Travel credits cover goods and services for own use or to give away acquired by non-residents from an economy during visits to that economy. Travel debits cover goods and services for own use or to give away acquired from other economies by residents of the reporting economy during visits to these other economies. The most common goods and services covered are lodging, food and beverages, entertainment and transportation (within the economy visited), gifts and souvenirs. Travel services include: (i) personal travel and (ii) business travel.

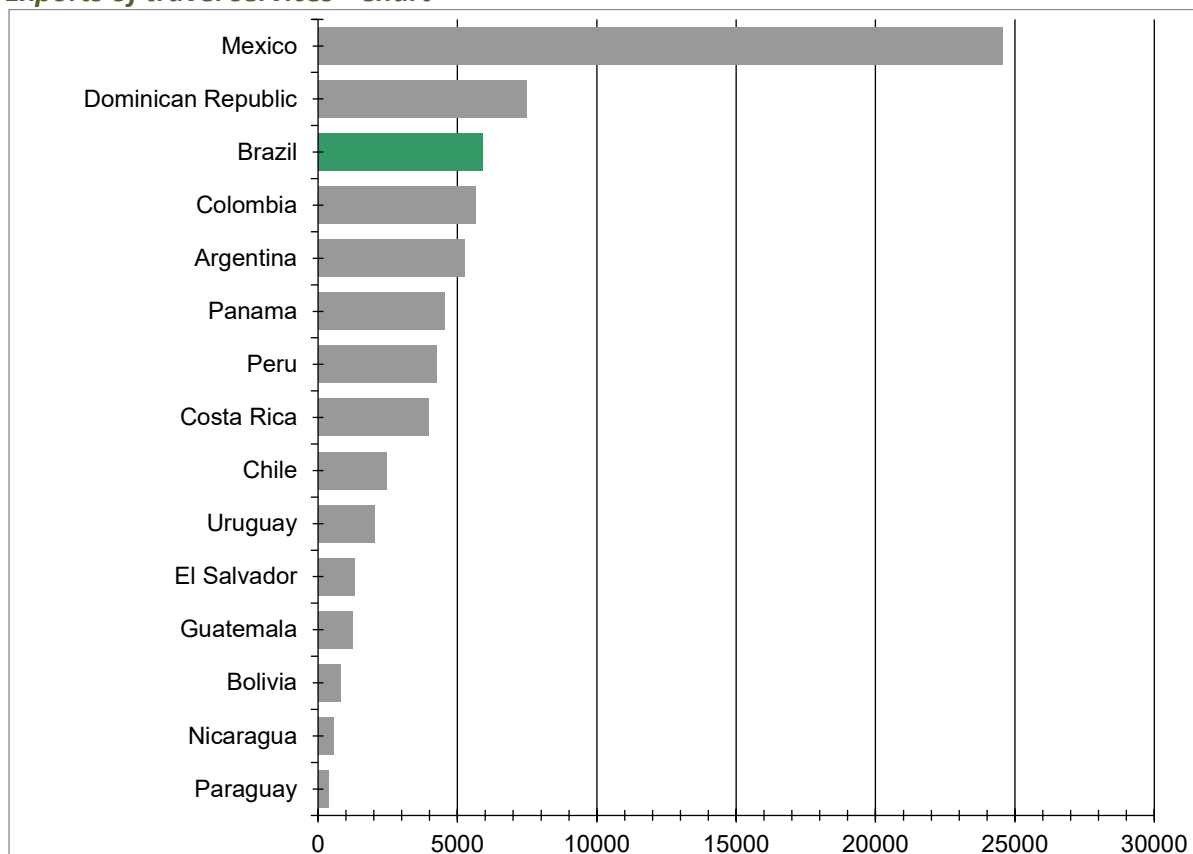
